Deadlines end at 5 p.m. on the specified date unless otherwise noted. When a deadline falls on a weekend, the deadline is extended to the following Monday. This University Calendar is the most current listing of important semester dates.

<b>LAST DAY TO PAY TUITION AND FEES for students who registered April 7 –August 19, 2008</b>	August 20, 2008 (Wednesday)	<b>BILLS ARE NOT MAILED. ANYONE WHO HAS NOT PAID BY THIS DATE WILL LOSE THEIR REGISTRATION AND MUST REGISTER DURING THE NEXT SPECIFIED REGISTRATION PERIOD.</b>
Late Registration and add/drop for <b>paid students only.</b>	August 22–23 (Friday–Saturday)	Only paid students may make schedule changes.
Late registration and add/drop.	August 24–September 3	All admitted students may register or add/drop classes via ASAP with appropriate approvals.

100% Tuition and Fees Refund	August 26 (Tuesday)	Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a <b>100%</b> refund of tuition and fees.
First Day of Class	August 27	Classes begin for the Fall 2008 Semester.
Labor Day	September 1 (Monday)	University closed. Classes do not meet.
Deadline to Add a class or late register	September 3 (Wednesday)	Last day to add a class or late register.
80% Tuition and Fees Refund		Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive an <b>80%</b> refund of tuition and fees.
Deadline to Request Challenge Examination	September 4 (Thursday)	Last day to request Challenge Examination from the instructor. Challenge Examination should be administered by September 17.
“Drop Only” by ASAP	September 4–October 30	Any student may drop an individual course via ASAP and receive a grade of “W.” (Courses officially dropped before Census Date [September 12] will not appear on the student’s transcript.)

70% Tuition and Fees Refund	September 10 (Wednesday)	Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a <b>70%</b> refund of tuition and fees
CENSUS DATE, 5 P.M.	September 12 (Friday, 5 p.m.)	Last day to: drop or withdraw without a grade, or drop an individual course and receive a <b>100%</b> refund. <b>NO REFUNDS GIVEN FOR DROPPING AN INDIVIDUAL COURSE AFTER THIS DATE.</b>
Fall 2008 Graduation Application Deadline (Graduate Level)	September 15 (Monday)	Deadline for Fall 2008 Master’s and Doctoral degree candidates to apply for graduation. Visit the <a href="#">Graduation Web page</a> for more information.
Challenge Examination Requests	September 17 (Wednesday)	Last day to submit challenge examination request to ESC. Challenge Examination should be administered by September 17.
50% Refund Deadline		Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a <b>50%</b> refund of tuition and fees
25% Tuition and Fees Refund	September 24 (Wednesday)	Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a <b>25%</b> refund of tuition and fees.

Second Installment Payment Due	September 30 (Tuesday)	Second installment payment is due for students who select the three payment plan.
Promissory Notes Due	October 14(Tuesday)	Deadline for students on the installment payment plan to have a promissory note on file in the Fiscal Services Office.
Credit/No Credit Option Due	October 23 (Thursday)	Deadline to choose credit/no credit grading option (undergraduate only).
Sophomores and above: Automatic "W" deadline and Drop Only ends	October 30 (Thursday)	Last day for Sophomores and above (30 or more credit hours earned) to drop an individual course or withdraw from all classes and receive an automatic grade of "W." An individual course may not be dropped after this date without withdrawing from all classes. Sophomore and above drop only ends.
Sophomore and above: withdrawal Timeframe  Freshmen: Automatic "W"/ withdrawal timeframe	October 31–December 3	Time frame for Sophomores and above (30 or more credit hours earned) to withdraw from all classes. A grade of "W" will be given for each class a student is passing.* A grade of "F" will be given for any class a student is failing. (student must see advisor)  Time frame for Freshmen (29 or fewer credit hours earned) to drop an individual course or withdraw from all classes and receive an automatic grade of "W"(student must see advisor).
Final Installment Payment Due	November 4 (Tuesday)	Final installment payment is due for students who select the three payment plan.
Graduation Application Deadline (Undergraduate)	November 15 (Saturday)	Deadline for Spring 2009 undergraduate degree candidates to apply for graduation. Visit the <a href="#">Graduation Web page</a> for more information.
Thanksgiving Holidays	November 27–29 (Thursday–Saturday)	University Closed. Class do not meet.
Sophomores and above: withdrawal deadline  Freshmen: Automatic "W"/ withdrawal deadline	December 3 (Wednesday)	Last day for Sophomores and above (30 or more credit hours earned) to withdraw from all classes. Courses may not be dropped or withdrawn after this date.** Last day for freshmen (29 or fewer credit hours earned) to drop an individual course or withdraw from all classes and receive an automatic grade of "W."
Student Study Days	December 8–9 (Monday–Tuesday)	Classes do not meet.
Final Examinations	December 10–16(Wednesday–Tuesday)	No Final Examinations on Sunday.
Commencement Ceremonies	December 18–20 (Thursday–Saturday)	Check University calendar for ceremony details

\*After the automatic "W" and withdrawal dates students may not drop courses, or withdraw, except with the approval of the course instructor and the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled.

\*\*Students may withdraw from all classes via ASAP prior to the beginning of the semester. Beginning with the first day of classes (August 27), students may not drop their last class via ASAP, but must complete a withdrawal form. Withdrawal forms are available online, at the Enrollment Services Center, and at all academic advising centers.
