

**PHOTOGRAPHER:** The Department of Art and Art History at the University of Texas at San Antonio invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant Professor appointment of an artist/photographer, with a competitive salary and benefits package, to oversee the photography program commencing Fall semester 2008 pending budget approval. Applicants must have an MFA degree in Art and at least three years of college level teaching experience beyond graduate school, as well as a significant record of exhibitions and be able to instruct courses involving wet lab, large and small format cameras and digital processes. Familiarity with photographic history and interest in furthering the photography program profile regionally and nationally are an assets. The successful candidate will demonstrate the ability to work in an integrated studio environment, and teach undergraduate and graduate courses in BFA and MFA studio programs. The regular teaching course load is 3-2, plus creative/research activities and committee obligations. Applicants with diverse cultural, ethnic and national perspectives are welcome.

The deadline for application is January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2008. All applications will be acknowledged and reviewed in the order they are received. This review will continue until the position is filled. Applicants must submit: 1) a letter of application, 2) a current resumé, 3) documentation of creative work in CD, DVD or slide form, 4) the names, postal and email addresses, and telephone numbers of three references, 5) a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of materials.
