



CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS !

The Department of Philosophy and Classics invites submissions for the **2017-2018 Graduate Student Essay Prize**. Essays in all traditions and areas of philosophy are welcome, and papers that have been written for coursework at UTSA are also encouraged.

The awards will be made to current UTSA Philosophy graduate students who, in the judgment of the Philosophy faculty, submit the best essays to the competition. (If no papers of sufficient quality are submitted, the faculty may decline to give an award.)

Submission information:

UTSA Philosophy graduate students enrolled during SY 17-18 are eligible to submit.

Word length must be between 3,000-5,000 words (longer essays will not be read). Submissions should be double-spaced, between 10-12 point font, and should include page numbers and proper citations.

Essays should be prepared for anonymous review, which means they should not include the author's name. Instead, a cover page for the submission should be included as a separate attachment. The cover page should include the author's name, paper title, and the word count of the paper.

Submissions must be made as two email attachments (paper and cover page), electronically to the Graduate Advisor of Record (GAR), joshua.thurow@utsa.edu. Indicate in the subject line that the essay is a submission for the Graduate Student Essay Prize.

***Deadline:* The essay is due electronically by 12pm (noon), on April 28, 2018.** Authors of the winning essays may be invited to present their work at a department colloquium in the following fall semester.
