Due to the high demand for intern slots, a waiting list is a common occurrence. UTSA policy requires all candidates will have a criminal background check.

- Potential interns are asked to submit applications at least one semester ahead of the desired term.
- Volunteers are taken when schedules can be accommodated.
- Priority is given to UTSA students, anthropology students and to graduating seniors.

Although, no experience is required, the ability to work at least 3-4 hours at a time, sometimes doing repetitive work and the ability to lift up to 30 pounds, is necessary.
