### **Summary Statement**

I believe that human communication allows for the creation of knowledge, the sustenance of meaning, and the genesis and maintenance of life giving relationships. I desire to challenge students by creating learning experiences that foster discovery, collaboration, and growth.

My goals for continuing excellence in instruction are (a) to help students create and sustain relationships and meaning to meet the professional, academic, and personal needs, (b) to provide students with powerful communication skill sets, knowledge, and abilities rooted in academic research and theory, and (c) to meet the cognitive, psychomotor, and affective needs of students as they develop across diverse communication contexts. To help students meet these goals I will continue to develop effective instruction through pedagogical, programmatic, and professional development. Effective communication instruction must involve considerations of rhetorical, relational, and practical needs to help students create critical understanding and habits of mind for a lifetime of success. Therefore, the most important anchoring principles of my teaching philosophy are kaizen, innovation in praxis, and student-centered teaching relationships.
